



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Note: FSNAU EW-EA database and dashboard (http://dashboard.fsnau.org) was developed through a consultative process and uses data on a diverse range of indicators (climate, market, nutrition, health and population displacement) that have been assigned individual thresholds for Normal, Alert and Alarm.

The EW-EA time series maps show trends in the number of Early Warning indicators that are in 'Alarm' phase month-on-month from 2020 to 2025. The varying degrees of red coloration on the map corresponds with how many indicators are in the Alarm phase in each district during a given month. The red bands in increasing intensity are 2, 4, 6, 8+ Indicators in Alarm Phase. Areas displayed in predominantly yellow color reflect less than 2 indicators in Alarm phase.
