

#### **Highlights**

**Inflation:** Somali Shilling (SOS)-using areas: Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased at mild rates (1-3%) in June 2021 compared to May 2021 in northeast and southern regions while it remained relatively stable (1%) in Central region. Compared to the five-year average for June (2016-2020), CPI increased (16-32%) across all regions of Somalia due to higher prices of sorghum (the main local cereal used in the consumption basket) and increases in imported food prices this year.

Somaliland Shilling (SLS)-using areas: CPI increased (2-4%) in June 2021 compared to both May 2021 and the five-year average for June (2016-2020).

**Exchange rate:** SOS-using areas: Exchange rates between the SOS and the United States Dollar (USD) remained relatively stable in most regions of Somalia in June 2021 compared to May 2021. Compared to the five-year average, SOS depreciated at moderate rates (7-11%) in central and southern regions of the country. However, depreciation against the USD was highest in northeast region (39%) due to continued circulation of large amount of locally printed SOS currency notes in these markets in recent years.

SISh-using areas: the exchange rate between the SLS and the USD exhibited relative stability in June 2021 compared to May 2021 but slightly gained (2%) compared to five-year average for June (2016-2020).

Local cereal (white maize, red sorghum and white sorghum): Local cereal prices mostly exhibited mild changes ( $\leq \pm 1$ -6%) in most regions of the country in June 2021 compared to May 2021. Specifically, white maize prices increased in Juba Valley (4%) but slightly decreased in Shabelle (2%) and Banadir (6%), red sorghum prices increased in northeast (5%) and Sorghum Belt (6%) while white sorghum prices mildly increased in Hiran (3%) but remained relatively stable in northwest (1%) regions. These increases



can be attributed to seasonal price trends during the lean season and reduced market supply because of low carryover stock from previous harvests. Similarly, compared to the five-year average for June (2016-2020), local cereal prices in June 2021 were higher (2-50%) in most regions due to reduced supply this year.

**Prices of imported food** items (rice, sugar, vegetable oil, wheat flour) exhibited mild ( $\leq \pm 10\%$ ) changes (mostly increases) in June 2021 compared to May 2021 across most regions of Somalia attributable to the increasing global food prices. Compared to the five-year average, prices of most food imports were higher in most regions of Somalia: south (2-49%), central (18-34%) and northwest (8-22%). However, price increases were significantly higher in northeast markets (26-70%). This is partly due to rising food prices on the international market and depreciation of the local SOS currency this year.

**Livestock (local quality goat and camel) prices** mostly declined at mild rates ( $\leq \pm 10\%$ ) in most regions across the country in June 2021 compared to May 2021, attributable to increased supply and low demand following imposed restrictions on travel for Hajj festivals by Saudi Arabia government due to COVID-19. However, compared to the five-year average, livestock prices are still higher in most regions of Somalia: south (8-22%), central (11-19%) and northwest (5-6%). Price increases were even higher in northeast regions (38-61%) due to loss of purchasing value of the local currency this year.

Milk prices (camel and cattle) mostly declined (1-15%) across the country due to increased milk availability as a result of improved water, browse and pasture availability that followed increased rainfall between late-April and early to mid-May. Compared to the five-year average for June (2016-2020), cattle milk prices mostly exhibited mild to moderate increases (4-15%) in the Juba and Sorghum-belt regions but lower (2%) in Banadir and Shabelle regions; while remaining stable in northwest regions. On the other hand, camel milk prices exhibited decreases (4-25%) in most regions of the country with the exception of Sorghum Belt and Shabelle Valley regions where camel milk prices increased (9-11%) due to high demand from Mogadishu.

**Labour (unskilled) wages** remained relatively stable or changed at mild rates ( $\leq \pm 13\%$ ; mostly declines) in most regions across the country in June 2021 compared to May 2021. Compared to the five-year average, labor wages are higher (7-52%) in Banadir, sorghumbelt, central and northern regions attributable to improvement in employment opportunities as a result of relative stability and improved security in urban areas this year. However, labour wage rates were slightly lower (5%) in Shabelle valley while they remained stable in Juba valley compared to five-year average.

**Terms of Trade (ToT)** between daily labour wage and cereals either remained stable or declined by 1kg across all regions in June 2021 compared to May 2021. Similarly, compared to the five-year average for June (2016-2020), ToT between daily labor and cereals either remained relatively stable or declined (by 1-2kgs) in most regions of the country due to increases in cereal prices this year.

ToT between local quality goat and cereal prices was lower in June 2021 compared to May 2021 across regions of the country attributable to decreased goat prices and/or increase in cereal prices. Similary, compared to the five-year average for June (2016-2020), the ToT between local quality goat and cereals was lower in most regions of the country attributable to higher cereal prices this year. Exception is Lower Shabelle where the TOT was higher (by 15%) compared to the five-year average due to higher goat prices this year

Figure 2: Terms of Trade Between Wage Rates and Selected Cereals





Figure 4: Monthly Trends in Consumer Price Index (CPI, March 2007=100)






Figure 3: Monthly Exchange Rate for Selected Regions (SoSh and SISh to USD)




Figure 5: Monthly Trends in Local Cereal Prices




Figure 1: Wheat Prices: Mogadishu and Bossaso Markets

Figure 6: Trends in Cereal Prices




Figure 8: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate









Figure 7: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power






Figure 14: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate













Figure 15: Goat Local Quality





Figure 20: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate



Figure 19: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power







Figure 23: Water Drum (200 litres)




Figure 24: Trends in Cereal Prices


Figure 25: Bakara: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power





Figure 26: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate









Figure 30: Trends in Cereal Prices









Figure 32: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate












#### Figure 38: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate





Figure 37: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power







Figure 41: Water Drum (200 litres)




Figure 44: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate




Figure 46: Exchange Rate








Figure 43: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power














#### Figure 48: Berbera Livestock Exports (Number of Heads)




#### Figure 49: Bossaso Livestock Exports (Number of Heads)
