# Market Update





October 2019 Update (Issued November 26, 2019)

#### **Highlights**

#### Inflation:

SoSh (Somali Shilling)-using areas: Consumer Price Index (CPI) remained stable or changed mildly (1-2%) in October 2019. Compared to the five-year average (2014-2018), CPI increased moderately (9%) in southern Somalia and (14%) in the northeast attributable to higher prices of commodities this year, especially cereals, in the Minimum Expenditure Basket (MEB).

SISh (Somaliland Shilling)-using areas: CPI remained relatively stable in October 2019 but increased by 8 percent compared to the five-year average for 2014-2018.

#### **Exchange rate:**

SoSh-using areas: The exchange rates between SoSh and the United States Dollar (USD) remained relatively stable in most regions of the country in October 2019. Compared to the five-year average, SoSh exhibited a moderate to significant depreciation (9-32%) in all regions of the country with the highest depreciation reported in the northeast mainly due to increased injection of newly printed local currency over the past two years.

SISh-using areas: local currency in Somaliland Shilling using areas exhibited mild depreciation (3%) against USD in October 2019 as well as in comparison to the five-year average.

**Local cereal** (white maize, red sorghum and white sorghum) prices either remained relatively stable or exhibited mild (≤4%) monthly increases in October 2019 in most parts of the country. The mild increases are due to dwindling supply because of the poor 2019 Gu season cereal harvest and limited carryover stocks from previous seasons. Compared to the five-year average, October 2019 local cereal prices are higher (8-24%) in all regions across the country.

**Prices of imported food** (rice, sugar, vegetable oil, wheat flour) mostly exhibited relative stability or mild monthly changes ( $\leq \pm 10\%$ ) in local currency terms in October 2019 in most Southern regions of Somalia compared to last month and the five-year averages. In the

northern parts of the country, the prices of most food imports remained relatively stable in October 2019 but exhibited mild to moderate increases (2-18%) compared to the five-year average.

Livestock prices for local quality goat and camel mostly exhibited mild to moderate monthly increases (<8%) in most regions across Somalia in October 2019, mainly due to improved livestock body conditions that followed increased availability of pasture and water. Compared to the five-year average, livestock prices exhibited mild to moderate increases (5-23%) across the country. Milk prices (camel and cattle) exhibited mild to moderate decreases (less than 15%) in most regions of the country both in October 2019 and compared to the five-year average. This is due to increased milk availability as improved pasture and water positively impacted on milk yields per animal in addition to increased number of animals giving birth and lactating in October.

Labor (unskilled) wages increased mildly (2%) in the Sorghum Belt (Gedo, Bay, Bakool and Hiran regions) and moderately (14%) in Middle and Lower Shabelle regions due to improved agriculture labor opportunities but declined in the Jubas regions (by 19%) because of ongoing floods which hindered crop cultivation and planting. However, wage rates remained relatively stable in central and northern regions in October 2019. Compared to the five-year average, labor wages remained relatively stable (0-4%) in the Sorghum Belt and Shabelle regions but declined in the Juba regions (-18%). In the central and northern regions, wages were significantly higher (14-39%).

**Terms of Trade (ToT)** between daily labor wage and cereals either remained relatively stable or changed mildly (by  $\pm$ /- 1-2kgs/daily wage) in most regions of the country in October 2019. Similarly, the labor wage to cereals ToT remained relatively stable or decreased mildly in most regions compared to the five-year average (2014-2018), with the exception of central and northwest regions where ToT increased (by 2-4kgs/daily) owing to labor wage rates that are currently higher. The ToT between local quality goat and cereals exhibited mild monthly changes ( $\le \pm 10\%$ ) in most regions of the country. Five-year average comparisons indicate lower ToT between goat and cereals in the southern regions of Somalia due to higher cereal prices in October 2019; and higher ToTs in the Central and Northern regions due to currently higher livestock prices.

#### Siege-affected towns (Bulo-Burto, Wajid, Dinsor and Hudur)

**Labor (unskilled) wages** exhibited moderate increases (11-16%) in Wajid and Dinsor but declined slightly (3-5%) in Hudur and Buloburto markets in October 2019. Compared to the five-year average, labor wages were higher in all the markets except Dinsor which exhibited a decline of 9 percent.

**Terms of Trade (ToTs)** between daily labor wages and local cereals exhibited relative stability (0-1kg) in October 2019 across the four markets. TOT between goat and cereal exhibited mild decrease in Wajid (65 kg to 63kg) but a moderate increase in Hudur (56kg to 66kg), while remaining stable in Buloburto and Dinsor. Compared to the five year average, TOT decreased in all four markets attributable to increase in cereal prices and/or decrease in daily labor wage rates and goat prices.

**Local cereal (red and white sorghum)** prices mostly remained high but stable in October 2019 owing to the poor Gu 2019 season cereal production and reduced cereal supply from adjacent regions. Cereal prices exhibited moderate to significant increases (9-55%) in comparison to the five-year average.

**Prices of imported food items** (rice, sugar, vegetable oil, wheat flour) mostly exhibited moderate to significant increases (8-50%) in October 2019 as well as in comparison to the five-year averages in Hudur, Wajid and Dinsor markets due to limited supply as roads became impassable due damages to road infrastructure caused by heavy rainfall. In Buloburto market, price decreases of (9-15%) were recorded for most of the food imports due to better access and increased humanitarian assistance in response to floods.

Figure 2: Terms of Trade Between Wage Rates and Selected Cereals






Figure 4: Monthly Trends in Consumer Price Index (CPI, April 2007=100)

Figure 3: Monthly Exchange Rate for Selected Regions (SoSh and SISh to USD)





Figure 5: Monthly Trends in Local Cereal Prices

Figure 6: Trends in Cereal Prices





Figure 8: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate






Figure 7: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power




Figure 9: Goat Local Quality





Figure 11: Water Drum (200 litres)

Figure 12: Trends in Cereal Prices




Figure 14: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate






Figure 13:Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power





Figure 15: Goat Local Quality




Figure 20: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate






Figure 19: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power




Figure 25: Bakara: Trends in Wage Rates and Relative Purchasing Power




Figure 26: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate




Figure 27: Goat Local Quality





Figure 32: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate






Figure 31: Trends in wage rates and relative purchasing power




Figure 35: Water Drum (200 litres)





Figure 38: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate











Figure 44: Imported Commodity Prices Compared to Exchange Rate




Figure 46: Exchange Rate

Figure 48: Berbera Livestock Exports (Number of Heads)





